

PATENT AND PROPRIETARY MEDICINES VENDORS LICENSE (PPMVL) PROCEDURE.

1)All intending Vendors are required to pick application forms (form M1) from their respective States PPMVL committees. The duly completed forms are to be accompanied with the following document.

- Handwritten application letter
- Two reference letters on behalf of the intending vendor
- Income tax clearance certificate
- Birth certificate(duplicate)
- Evidence of educational qualification
- Evidence of payment
- Inspection report to be completed by the PIC members (400m from registered Pharmacy and 200m from PMS)

NB Form MII is only for renewals

- 2) The documents are forwarded to the State PPMVL committee for further directive. The committee may wish to conduct oral or written interview.
- 3) The processed documents are forwarded to the Registry for recommendation, approval and printing.
- 4) The Recommended vendors are requested to paid the sum of five thousand Naira (N5000) before license are printed and dispatch to respective States.

ISSUES THAT CAN HINDER LICENCING OF ANY VENDOR

- 1) The use of form MI instead of MII
- 2) Forms not dully endorse
- Distances on inspection report not stated or not more than 400m and 200m for pharmacy and PMS respectively.
- 4) Vendor not paying the prescribed fees
- 5) Vendor failed interview

These and many other non-compliance to the guideline can hinder the issuance of licence.
